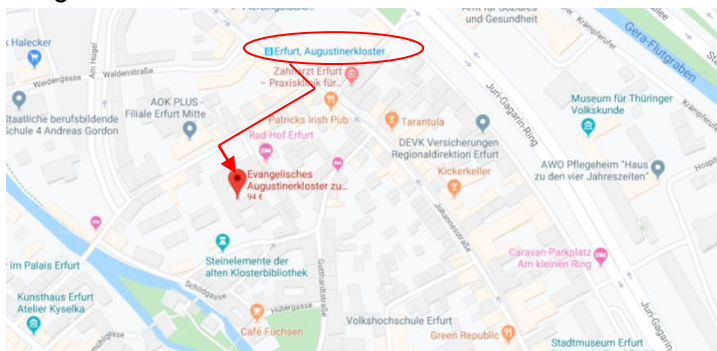

If traveling with the German Rail (Deutsche Bahn), we recommend traveling to Erfurt Main Train Station (Erfurt "Hauptbahnhof") and from there to connect with the street tram number 1 in the direction "Europaplatz" or the number 5 in the direction "Zooplatz". These trams leave from the lower level of the "Hauptbahnhof" about every 10 minutes during business hours. Exit the tram once you reach the stop "Augustinerkloster".

The event venue is located roughly 200 yards away from the stop "Augustinerkloster". If possible, please walk southeastwards along street "Johannesstraße" (in the opposite direction of the tram) and take the first right onto "Augustinerstraße". The venue is located about 100 yards down this road on your left side when walking from Johannesstraße.

If traveling by car, exit Autobahn A7 at "Buttelstedt/Erfurt-Ringelberg/Erfurt-Kerspleben/Erfurt-Zentrum" and at the T-intersection turn right (onto "Leipziger Straße"). Then go as follows: Turn right onto "Stauffenbergallee", left onto "Franckestraße", right onto "Juri-Gagarin-Ring" from which you will continue straight onto "Am Hügel" and finally turn left onto "Augustinerstraße".
